1. Activities Completed During the Week Ending 3/1/2019

- DCF rolled out one new hot fix this week with release 1.0.6 (See FASAMS Release Summary below).
- Two new enhancements were submitted to FEI for evaluation this week. The first was for ME
 Unique Client Identifier Reports. The second was for the Enabling and Disabling of User
 Account Functionality.
- Continuing to work with AHCA on a new Data Sharing Agreement required for Medicaid encounter data, the agreement is in review with Senior Management at AHCA.

- The incident management process will be revamped so that Tier 1 support will eventually come through the DCF help desk. Planned rollout is scheduled for 03/15/2019.
- A contract amendment is being created to allow the integration of SANDR into FASAMS by 6/30/2019. The amendment will be modified and reviewed next week by OITS Management and Contracts Management.
