

## **Training Outline for Safety Plans-1 Day (6 Hours)**

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### **Training Requirement:**

- Completed Safety Methodology Training and/or stop gap pre-service training for CM.
- Has completed at minimum of two (2) FFA's and a combination of either two (2) Impending Danger Safety Plans or one (1) Present Danger Safety Plan and one (1) Impending Danger Safety Plan
- Has completed at minimum of two (2) on-going FFA's for Case Management.

### **Trainer Preparation:**

- The training exercise at the conclusion of the day entails participants working through two Family Functioning Assessment and Impending Danger Safety Plans.
- The trainer will need to identify the Family Functioning Assessments and Impending Danger Safety Plans and create a Trainer guide to facilitate their discussion of the safety plan exercises.
- There should be one FFA with an in home plan and one with an out of home plan selected from the area/region.
