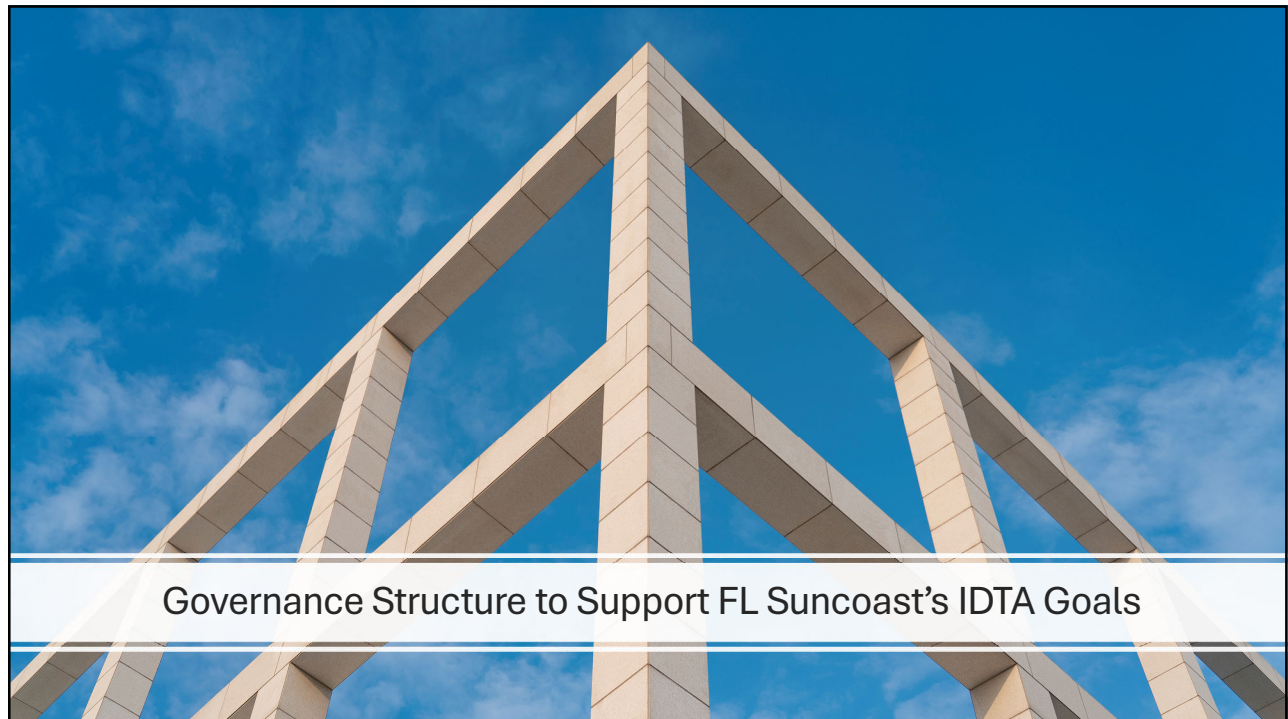

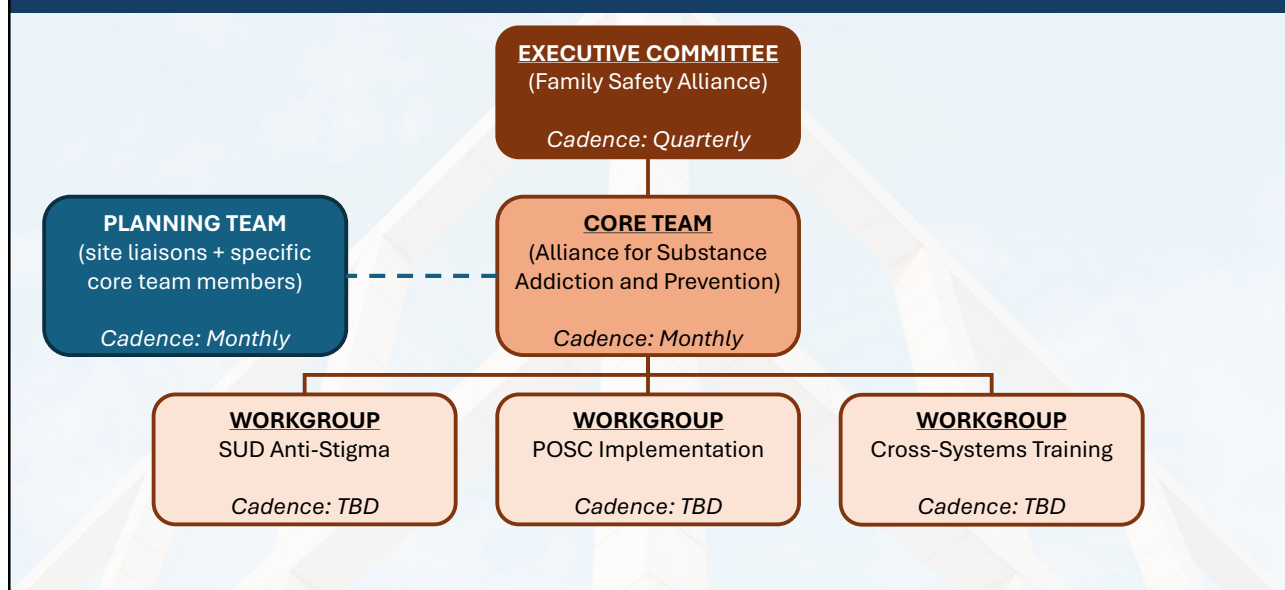

WORKGROUP

SUD Anti-Stigma



CHARGE

Identify and recommend approaches to be implemented in a successful anti-stigma campaign to support women affected by substance use during her perinatal journey.



POTENTIAL DELIVERABLES

- **Evaluate existing models** and recommend the most suitable for Suncoast
- **Identify and recommend** funding sources for the anti-stigma campaign.
- **Determine the necessity** of specific partners or vendors for the successful execution of the campaign.
- **Assess the need** for shared intellectual property and draft a Memorandum of Understanding if required.
- **Develop clear policies** to for informed consent and support for peers participating in the campaign.
- **Suggest specific products and approaches**, such as brochures, guidelines, and social media strategies, targeted at service providers and families.

WORKGROUP POSC Implementation



CHARGE

Identify solutions to increase the rate of universal verbal SUD screening and development of prenatal Plans of Safe Care in Suncoast Florida.



POTENTIAL DELIVERABLES

- **Identify barriers** to universal verbal SUD screening for healthcare providers
- **Provide new or support existing guidance** distinguishing verbal SUD screening from toxicology testing.
- **Recommend validated verbal SUD screening tools** for healthcare providers and outline trauma-informed implementation methods.
- **Develop a clear referral process** to the CAPTA program for creating a prenatal Plan of Safe Care.
- **Create guidance for child welfare staff** on assessing the efficacy of a prenatal Plan of Safe Care and supporting the newborn and family.
- **Review and improve guidelines for Plans of Safe Care** when prenatal substance exposure is identified at birth.
- **Recommend and pilot strategies** for scaling the Enhanced Plan of Safe Care Pathway.

WORKGROUP Cross-Systems Training and Monitoring



CHARGE

Identify barriers and solutions to improve cross systems training, monitoring, and data collection to support Plan of Safe Care implementation and evaluation



POTENTIAL DELIVERABLES

- **Determine modalities** (learning modules, toolkits, one pagers, website) are needed for optimal cross-system Plan of Safe Care Training
- **Review and update** the current Plan of Safe Care Training in each system.
- **Complete a data inventory** to identify what data points are currently collectable.
- **Develop collaborative outcome measures** that measure baseline outcomes and consensus on intended improvements.
- **Identify and implement mechanisms** to support monitoring family progress across systems.
- **Identify technology options** that support Plan of Safe Care monitoring (e.g social health information exchanges)
